Purpose and lawfulness - the processing of personal data is carried out exclusively for the purpose of participating in the **Sardine Contest – 2025 edition**, based on the Conditions of Participation, and for the subsequent public promotion of the event, relating to the **following purposes**:

- a. Registration of the application under the terms foreseen in article 5 of the current Conditions of Participation;
- b. Identification of the creators of the sardine designs submitted to the Sardine Contest – 2025 edition and respective contact information, under the terms foreseen in the Conditions of Participation;
- c. The organisation and production of the Sardine Contest 2025 edition;
- d. Selection of the winning designs in Sardine Contest 2025 edition, under the terms of the current Conditions of Participation;
- e. The announcement of the winners of the Sardine Contest 2025 edition competition in the media and on websites and social networks belonging to EGEAC and the Municipality of Lisbon, under the terms foreseen in the Conditions of Participation;
- f. Use of the name and/or other personal data relating to designs, whenever applicable, under the terms foreseen in article 1 of the Conditions of Participation;

- g. Legal requirements;
- h. Contest Archives;

The legal bases for the processing of personal data:

- a. The consent of the legal representative of the data subject to the processing of his/her personal data for the specific purposes mentioned above;
- b. The processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest by the controller and, where applicable, the processor, as part of their respective duties;
- c. The processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by a third party, except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject which require protection of personal data.

Personal data categories: The personal data collected are indicated on the application form.

Personal data conservation: The data collected shall be kept for the period of time necessary to fulfil the purposes for which they are processed and shall not be used for any other purposes.

Rights of data subjects: Data subjects have the following rights concerning their personal data:

[1] **To be exercised before EGEAC:** the right to information; the right of access; the right to rectify inaccurate data, the right to erasure, the right to restrict processing, the right to data portability, the right to object to processing; the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling; where consent has been given, the right to withdraw consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

[3] To be exercised before the supervisory authority (Comissão Nacional de Proteção de Dados): the right to lodge complaints.
